#### Forum timing

The event will start at the **Auditorium** (Pelham Room) in the Melbourne Business School (MBS) Conference Centre. The MBS Conference Centre is adjacent to the main building for the Melbourne Business School.

#### On arrival please go to the auditorium to sign in and grab a name tag.

There will be signage outside the building and the room for the Forum. We will also be using the Bouverie Room and Leicester Rooms for breakout sessions.


Lunch on day 1 will be in the Dining Hall of the main building (not auditorium) and in the Hub (main building) on day 2.
